### **GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS**

These instructions should be read carefully and retained after installation by the end user for future reference and maintenance.


These instructions should be used to aid installation of the following products: 050014, 050014B

### **SAFETY**

- Installation of this sensor should only be carried out by a qualified electrician or competent person to the latest Building and current IEE Wiring Regulations (BS7671)
- Please isolate mains prior to installation/maintenance
- Check the total load on the circuit does not exceed the rating of the circuit cable, fuse or circuit breaker
- Please note the IP (Ingress of Protection) rating of this sensor when deciding the location for installation
- This product is Class II double insulated
- This product is IP44 rated


# **INSTALLATION**

- Provide power to the required point of installation. Suitable IP rated junction boxes should be used where required
- We recommend an installation height of between 1.8m and 2.5m
- Remove the back cover by removing screw (see Fig 1) to access the terminal block



# Fig 1

- Using the back cover as a template, mark the location of the fixing holes and drill the holes ensuring not to infringe with any joists, gas or water pipes or electrical cables
- Connect the sensor to the luminaire and mains supply (via terminal connector) ensuring the correct polarity is observed. See Fig 2 for the wiring diagram (Live (brown), Neutral (blue) and Switched Live (A)



- Please see Fig 3 for sensor adjustments
- Replace back cover



